Assassins

THE ASSASSINATION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE
LONGSHOREMEN OF THE PORT OF SAN ANTONIO

Another of the innumerable murders committed under the pretext of an alleged "attempt to flee" was that of six longshoremen officials of San Antonio. They were arrested under the pretext that they had incited a strike. According to military proclamation number 26, by Colonel Manuel Contreras Sepulveda, and reprinted on page 2 of La Tercera, September 24th, they had attempted to flee during a breakdown of a truck that had been carrying them to the prison camp at Bulcalemu: all were killed. Their names: Fidel Alfonso bravo Alvarez, Raul Bacciarini Zorrila, Hector Rojo Alfaro, Samuel Munez, Armando Jimenez Pachuca, Guillermo Alvarez Canas.
