SOME DEAD PERSONS IN BIO-BIO

In September 27, workers of the paper factory of Laja were killed. In Santa Barbara that same month, 26 peasants were killed, among them three brothers, leaders of a cooperative farming settlement. They are Mariano, Domingo and Jose Godoy Acuna. Others included the President of the Cooperative of Santa Barbara, Juan Mellado, and Guillermo Purran, a Mapuche leader and a functionary of CORA (Corporation of Agrarian Reform).

In Angol, the son of a municipal councilman was killed, as well as the chief of the area of Victoria for CORA, a socialist activist. In Los Angeles, the son of Luis Tejada, and the sub-delegate of the government of Allende were taken prisoners and tortured. The provincial governor of Bio-Bio and his wife were detained and expelled from Chile.
