

Conclude that, in spite some developments partially occasioned by international concern that indicate some reduction in torture and arbitrary arrests, constant and flagrant violation of basic human rights and fundamental freedoms of the Chilean people as well as of individuals. continue to take place in Chile, and that the system of violation of human rights has now become institutionalized.

Concluding that, while certain developments related to individual cases may have taken place in Chile, mainly as a result of the continuous action of the international community, gross violations of human rights, in some cases systematic and institutionalized, continue to exist in that country.
