- 1. The Secretariat took note of an information on the situation in Chile given by Sergio Insunza. Amendments were made by M. Jääskeläinen W. Fortin and H.G. Franck.
- 2. The Secretariat took note of an information on the meeting of defence lawyers in Brussels given by the Secretary General. The Secretar riat appreciated the steps taken for the strengthening of the cooperation between the defence lawyers and the International Commission. The Secretariat took also note of an information on the planned visit to Chile by Jimenez, Calvi and H.G. Franck in the middle of March.

The Secretariat took note of the information on administrative arrangements for the Hearing given by H. Schiffner.

Date (27th-29th) and place (Helsinki) were confirmed.

The preliminary timetable was amended and accepted.

The Secretariat took note of the suggestions on press activities, the official opening and other administrative questions. The administrative working group innHelsinki was charged with the task of the further preparartion of the Hearing.

The Secretariat agreed to issue a press statement of the Secretariat (3 pages) and to send information letters to the Finnish mass media and the international press.

The list of invitations was amended and accepted (amendments: ICFTU, Christain Trade Unions, Int. Leafue for Peace and Freedom, Socialist International, observers from Red Cross and IPU, representatives from Norway, Sweden, Greta Britain, USSR, Senegal, USA, Netherlands, Mexico)

- 4. The Secretariat discussed the information on a National Hearing on Chile in Oslo on March 31st given by P. Kjellström. It was decided to study the possibilities of the International Commissonto participate at this event. Three members of the IC should be sent to Oslo (paid by the IC), three witnesses (trip made possible with help of the GDR) and three experts (trip made possible with help of the USSR)
- 5. The Secretariat decided that the nummer of Chilean witnesses should not exceed 11 persons.
- 6. The Secretariat decided that the Working Group (H.G. Franck, S.Zivs S.Insunza, W. Fortin) should prepare the necessary documents for the Hetring.
- 7. The Secretariat took note of an information on the Youth meeting in Paris (March 20/21) given by A. Padilla on behalf of the WFDY. It was decided to send a delegation of the IC to Paris.

 Four representatives of the Youth should be invited to attend the Hearing in Helsinki.
- 8. The Secretariat took note of the information on a Solidarity meeting in Helsinki on March 29th, 8 p.m. at the Finlandia Hall.
- 9. A working meeting of the Secretariat will be held in Stockholm on March 13th-14th, 1976. It should be attended by the Secretary General, S. Insanza, W. Fortin, H. Schiffner, S. Zivs and G. Uribe.
